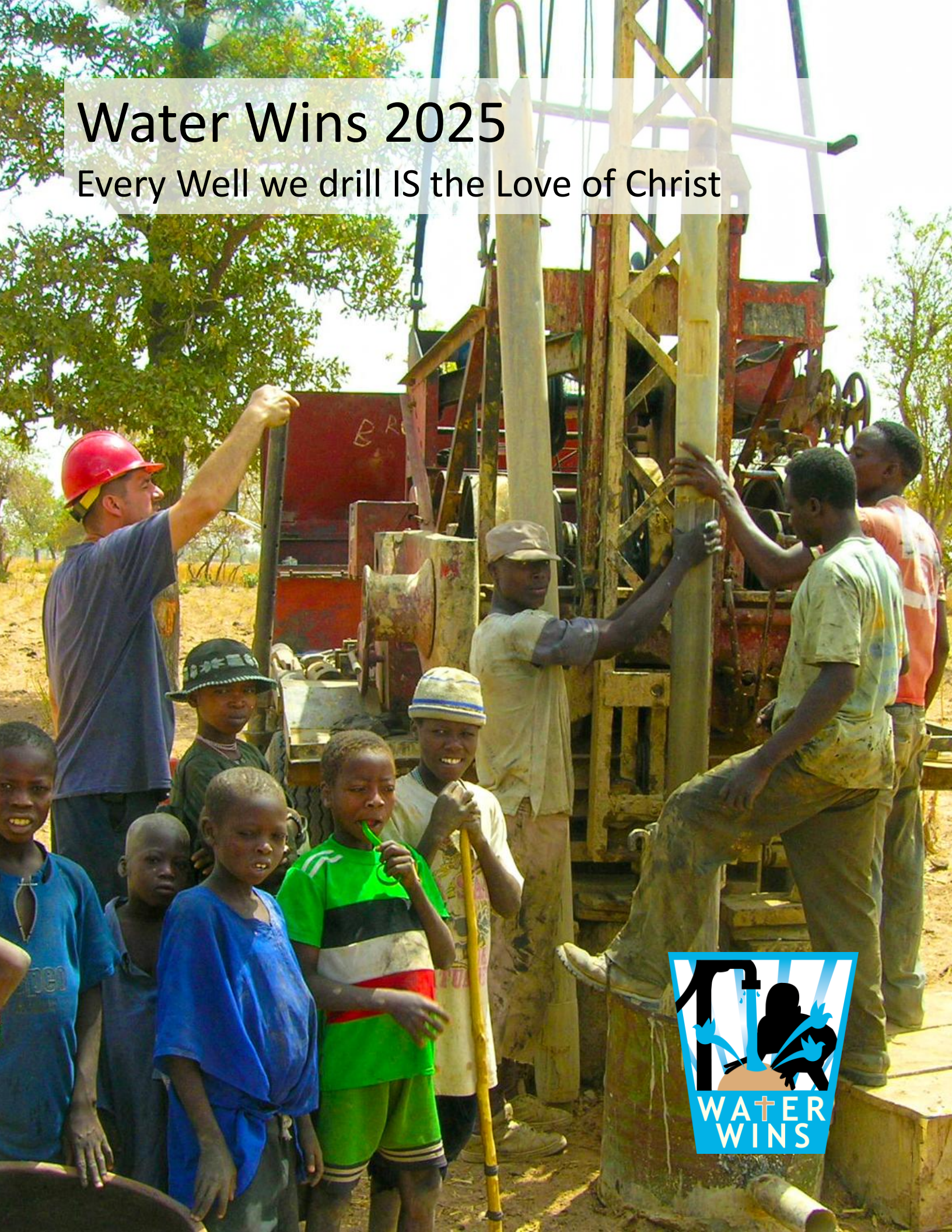

# Celebrating 20 Years of Water Wins

As we celebrate the birth of Christ this Christmas season, we rejoice that 2025 marked the 20th year of Water Wins' ministry in the Eastern Kambari Area (EKA) of Nigeria. Over these two decades, through God's grace, we have drilled and maintained over 500 wells, bringing life-sustaining water to countless communities. In addition, Water Wins has opened a school, established a health clinic, and added over a dozen Evangelists faithfully serving throughout the region. Through every challenge and every victory, **God has provided**. He has heard our prayers and used something as simple and as powerful as clean water to show His love.

## Updates and Prayers for 2026

**Safety & Prayer for Nigeria:** Life remains very challenging, and often dangerous, for Christians in Nigeria. This past year, eight EKA community members, including an Evangelist, were kidnapped. Praise God, all were released unharmed. Please continue to pray for protection over our Nigerian team, boldness for our Evangelists, and peace for all families living in Nigeria.

**Well Drilling:** We eagerly await a container of necessary equipment so we can begin drilling for the 2026 season. Our plan is to drill 30 wells, bringing hope and life to more communities. The need for a drill bit is urgent, and as we write this update, we coordinating a hand delivery so we can drill.

**Century Bike Ride 2025:** Thank you to all the riders and volunteers that supported this event in Chicago suburbs last fall. The 100-mile bike ride raised over \$60,000 for Water Wins! Praise God!

# Steve Buer – Drilling Legend, Faithful Servant

**Some thoughts shared by Doug Tubergen:** I met Steve 20 years ago, shortly after returning from my first trip to Nigeria in February 2005. Water Wins needed support from a professional well driller as we knew nothing about well drilling.

I stopped by Buer Well drilling in Caledonia in March of 2005. Steve was in the office that day and I explained that we found this very old Bucyrus Erie 20W drill rig in Nigeria that needed some attention. During our conversation Steve explained that he had just finished reading a book by Bruce Wilkinson called the **Dream Giver** and felt God calling him to find something in the well drilling field that he could steward. I told Steve that I also just finished reading the book. To this day I believe that was our first true connection – God had been leading us to service together.

In May of 2005, Steve and I headed to Nigeria so Steve could check out exactly what he was getting into. **Steve and I both shared a sense of adventure and God's calling to make His world a better place.**

That trip would become one of dozens we would take to train the team in the EKA on well drilling. This picture is of Steve and I on one of our early trips (Steve is also in the cover photo). Steve was a true teacher and a tremendous asset to Water Wins. Sadly, Steve passed away this fall after a courageous battle with cancer. **His legacy will live on in every drop of clean water, saving lives in Nigeria.**
